Important note for men: VMMC is just for men, but benefits women too. It is a small surgical procedure that involves the removal of the foreskin and if done by a medical professional, can prevent HIV by up to 60%, and offers partial prevention of a number of other STIs. VMMC only revents HIV for the person who is circumcised, and does not prevent HIV from exposures othe han sex. Side effects include some pain (that can be managed with medicine and ice packs) for u to a week after the procedure. VMMC does not prevent pregnancy, it is not recommended as the only HIV-prevention method if your partner is living with HIV, and it does not prevent HIV after a possible exposure. Always try to use an additional HIV-prevention method with VMMC.
