* Urinalysis should be offered as baseline screening when eGFR results are delayed, or when eGFR is not available in the health care facility. Waiting for eGFR result should not delay initiation of Oral PrEP. However, if urinalysis is not normal, Oral PrEP initiation should be delayed until creatinine result is available. eGFR should be performed at 6 months after initiation, and then annually.
