About the training package

The **HIV Prevention Ambassador Training Package (HPAT)** equips community members with knowledge about HIV prevention and PrEP options, including injectable lenacapavir (LEN PrEP).

Through this training, participants become **PrEP Ambassadors** – trusted peer educators, advocates, and supporters who help raise awareness, build trust, and connect people in their communities to PrEP services.

Who is the training for?

Two tailored versions of the training are available:

- Adolescent girls and young women (AGYW)
- Members of key and priority populations for PrEP

What does the package include?

Step-by-step guidance for trainers delivering the HPAT
- **Interactive Training Sessions**
Ready-to-use session plans covering HIV prevention, PrEP methods, and peer support
- **Ambassador Toolkit**
Practical, adaptable tools ambassadors can use in their community outreach
